

- \$15 cash payment only exact amount



- Do not cover: dental or eye care(unless accidental)
- Covered in USA stay less than 60 days

## **TAXES & TIPS**

### Taxes

- All prices are without taxes except for basic food products
- Generally add 15 %
- Tips
  - Not included on the bill in restaurants, bars, night-club
  - 15% of the total bill is the norm



## ALCOHOL & CIGARETTES Warning – Quebec strict laws

### It is forbidden:

To smoke within 9 meters of any public buildings

To smoke in restaurants, bars and night-clubs » **\$ 80 fine** Outside shelters are available most of the time

To drink in public areas » \$ 140 fine

Keep in mind that HEC security guards are allowed to give fines!
