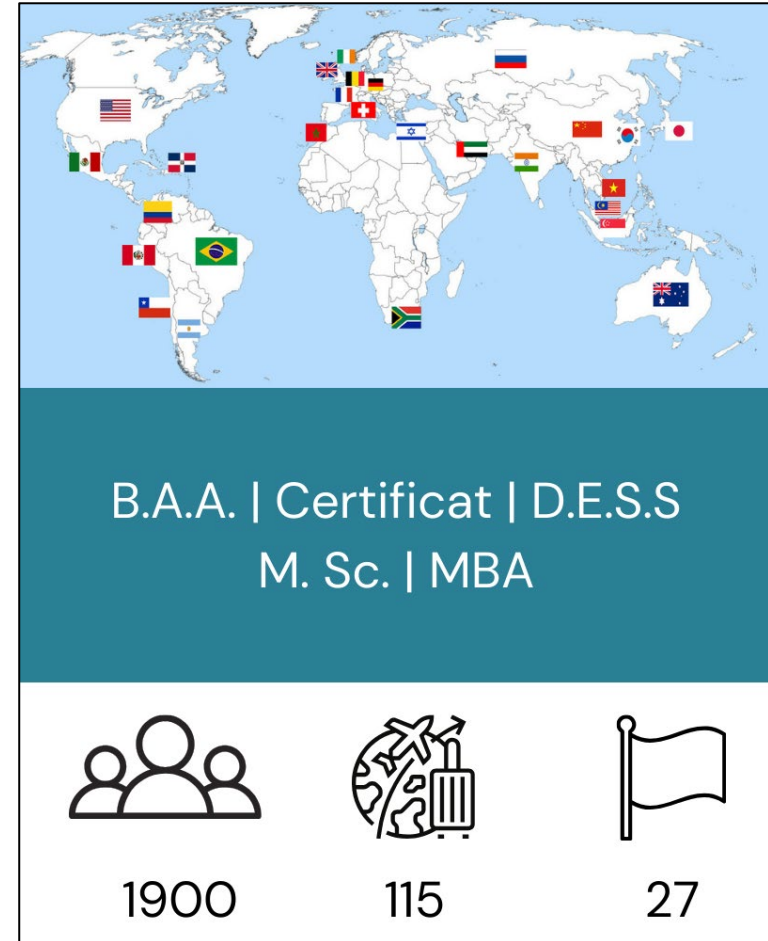

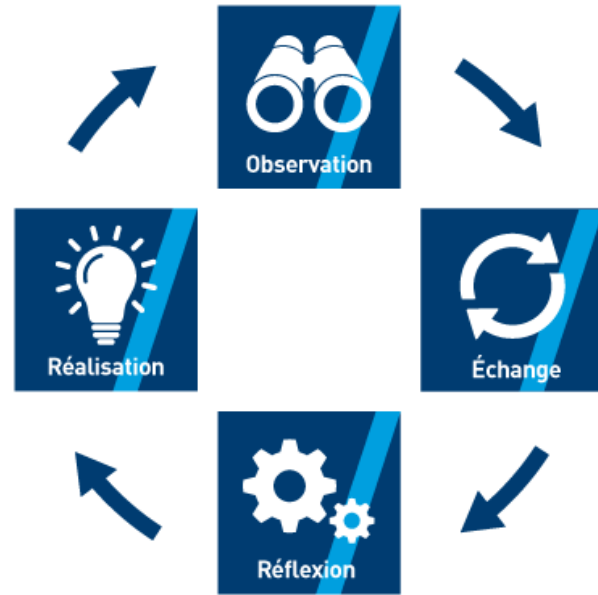


What is a Campus?

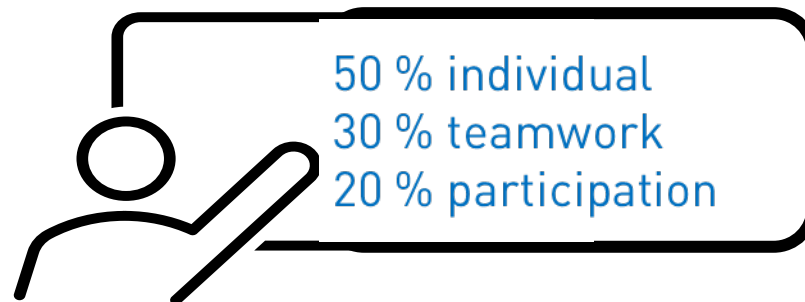
This is a summer course in international business whose goal is to promote the exchange with specialists, managers and business leaders to understand the practical aspects of the business world.

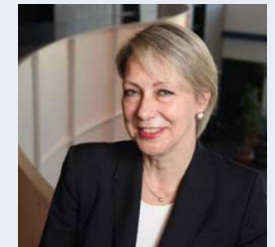

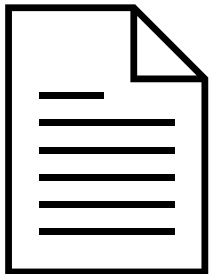

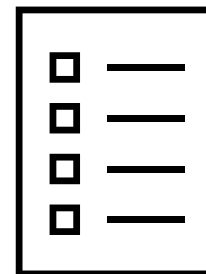

Criteria :

- Be between 18 and 35 years old
- Canadian citizenship or permanent residency and residence in Quebec
- A valid Quebec health insurance card (RAMQ)
- Studying full-time at time of departure
