Call for Candidates Canada Excellence Research Chairs

HEC Montréal is seeking outstanding candidates for the current Canada Excellence Research Chairs (CERC) competition. The <u>CERC program</u>, Canada's most prestigious Research Chair program, is designed to attract world-renowned researchers and their teams to launch ambitious research programs at Canadian universities. Applicants who match the desired profiles could be awarded a research chair valued at \$500,000 (CAD) per year for a period of 8 years (the amount could be higher if only one candidate is selected). Those who are conducting research that takes into account the principles of equity, diversity and inclusion are encouraged to apply.

TWO CHAIRS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE FOLLOWING FIELDS:

Natural Language Processing - NLP

Montréal has the reputation of being an international hub for artificial intelligent research. HEC Montréal is a founding member of IVADO, a state-of-the-art digital intelligence research institute, aiming to develop cutting edge knowledge in business intelligence, machine learning, and operational research. HEC Montréal is also an affiliate member of Mila, an artificial intelligence research institute that brings together more than 900 researchers specialized in machine learning.

• Environmental, social and governance issues (ESG)

 Contribute to branding Canada as a location of choice for world-leading research, science and technology development, alongside other federal programs with similar objectives.

REQUIREMENTS

- Be an associate or full professor
- Be internationally recognized as a leader in their field
- Have accomplishments that have made major societal impact (as appropriate based on career stage)
- Demonstrate their ability to support their research through external funding
- Have a record of attracting and mentoring a diverse group of students, trainees and research personnel, and establishing an equitable and inclusive research environment
- Be able to establish a high-calibre and diversified research team that will propel HEC
 Montréal to the forefront of developments in the priority fields
- Commit, once a chairholder, to integrating equity, diversity and inclusion into their team and research designs

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested candidates should send their application as soon as possible and before Friday, April 1st, 2022.

The application should include:

- a cover letter, stating the motivation for one of the two available chairs
- a description of the chair's research program relating to the select field, as well as the candidate's commitment to EDI (a maximum of two pages in total)
- an up-to-date curriculum vitae
- contact information for two referees

Conditional to the awarding of a research chair through the program, the nominee will be integrated into HEC Montréal's faculty as a professor.

Awardees will have up to 12 months to take up the award after the notice of award and acceptance has been signed by all parties.
