Oxford – HEC Montréal Scholarship program

Negotiation of a new fellowship with University of Oxford, ranked among the top 5 best universities in the world.

Information regarding the creation of the scholarship: The donor, Mr. Chagnon, had the opportunity to study in Oxford after graduating from HEC Montréal, he decided to offer \$ 1.25 million for a scholarship program between Oxford and HEC Montreal.

Scholarship details: This is a scholarship program that works both ways. Whether a graduate student of HEC Montreal who is admitted to Oxford or vice versa. Candidates must submit their application directly to Oxford in accordance with the conditions and deadlines. There are several deadlines (3), but Mr. Pasin advises students to present their file early in the process to increase their chances to be admitted.

Amount: \$ 90,000 for a HEC Montréal student studying at Oxford.

Selection of the fellow: Only one Fellow graduate from HEC Montréal will be chosen per year. Oxford is responsible for choosing the fellow. However, HEC Montréal could be consulted if necessary. No application for the scholarship is required, you just have to be accepted to Oxford to be considered by the Committee.

Requirements: We invite you to consult their <u>website</u> but it should be noted that the student must have a very good academic record (3.5 and +) and have passed the GMAT (around 700).

Programs: All programs offered by <u>Saïd Business School</u> give you the opportunity to receive this scholarship. There are some programs offered like <u>M.Sc Financial Economics</u>. Also, you could complete a Ph.D.
