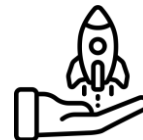

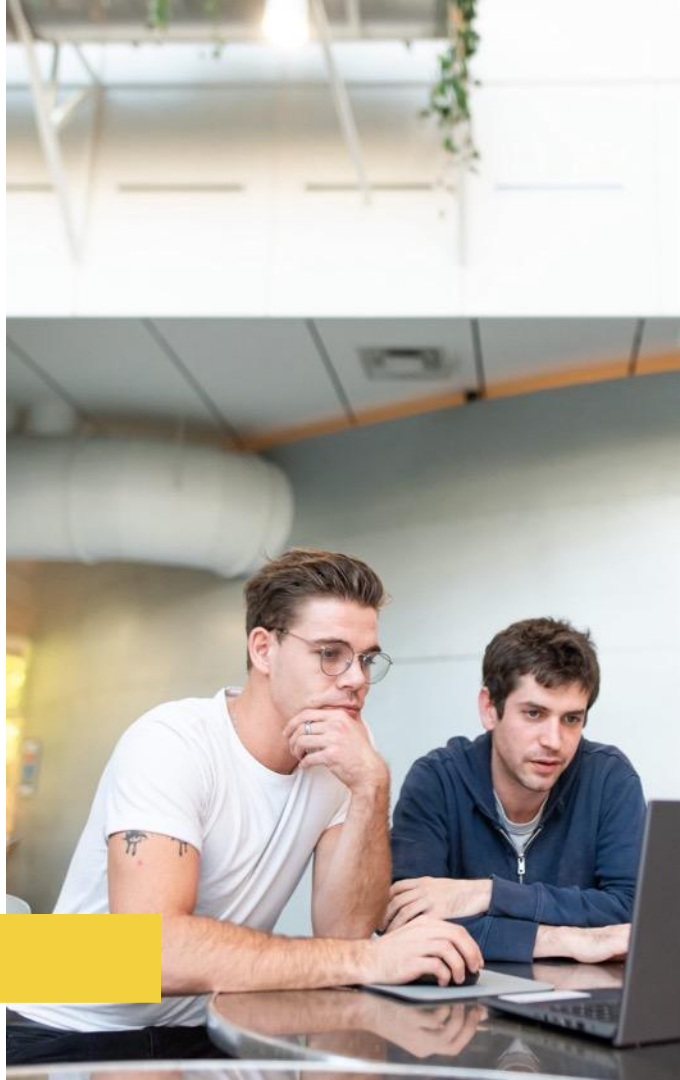
Main Eligibility Criterion

You must have completed and passed one term of your current study program to be eligible for scholarship competitions.

Need-based Bursaries

Help for a one-time need

- Main criterion: Experiencing temporary financial hardship
- Have an adequate cumulative GPA
- Complete a single online form for all financial aid and encouragement scholarships
- Provide the required supporting documents
- Confidentiality of applicants and scholarship recipients

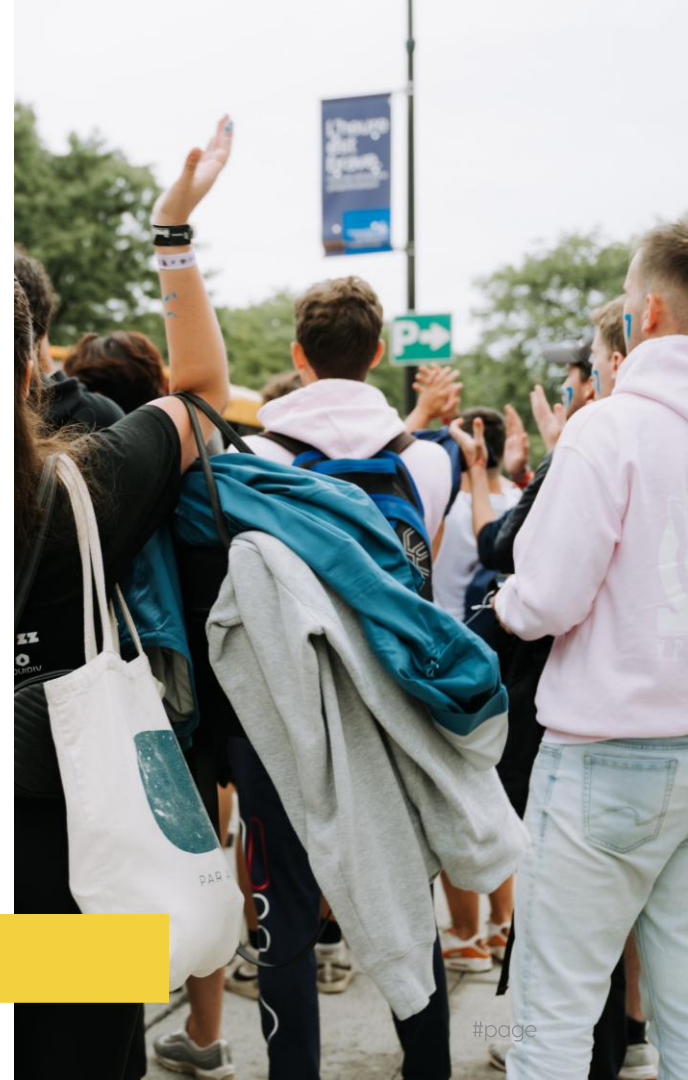
Recognition of perseverance

- Main criteria: [Effort and perseverance](#)
- Have an adequate cumulative GPA
- Complete a [single online form for all need-based and encouragement scholarships](#)
- Provide the required supporting documents

Leadership Scholarships

Recognizing involvement and leadership

- Main criterion: Stand out through involvement or achievement.
- Have an adequate cumulative GPA.
- Involvement over the last 12 months.
- Complete a single online form for all involvement and leadership scholarships.
- Provide the requested supporting documents.





Entrepreneurship Scholarships

Encouraging entrepreneurship

- Main criterion: present a [business model](#).
- Have an adequate cumulative GPA.
- Complete a single online form for all entrepreneurship scholarships.
- Provide the [required supporting documents](#) (next page).



Entrepreneurship Scholarships

Supporting documents

- Business model (within the form)
- Video (maximum two minutes)
- Letter of support (1 per candidate, maximum 1 page)
- CV
- Link to your LinkedIn page

Merit-based Scholarships

Rewarding excellence

- Main criterion: [Academic excellence](#)
- Cumulative GPA of approximately 3.7 or higher
- Complete a single online application form for most scholarships (some exceptions apply)

Some scholarships are awarded without an application.





Research Scholarships

Help fund research projects

- Main criteria: Submit a high-quality research project that meets the requirements.
- Have a good academic record.
- Complete an application form.
- Provide the required documents.
- The project must not be fully funded.

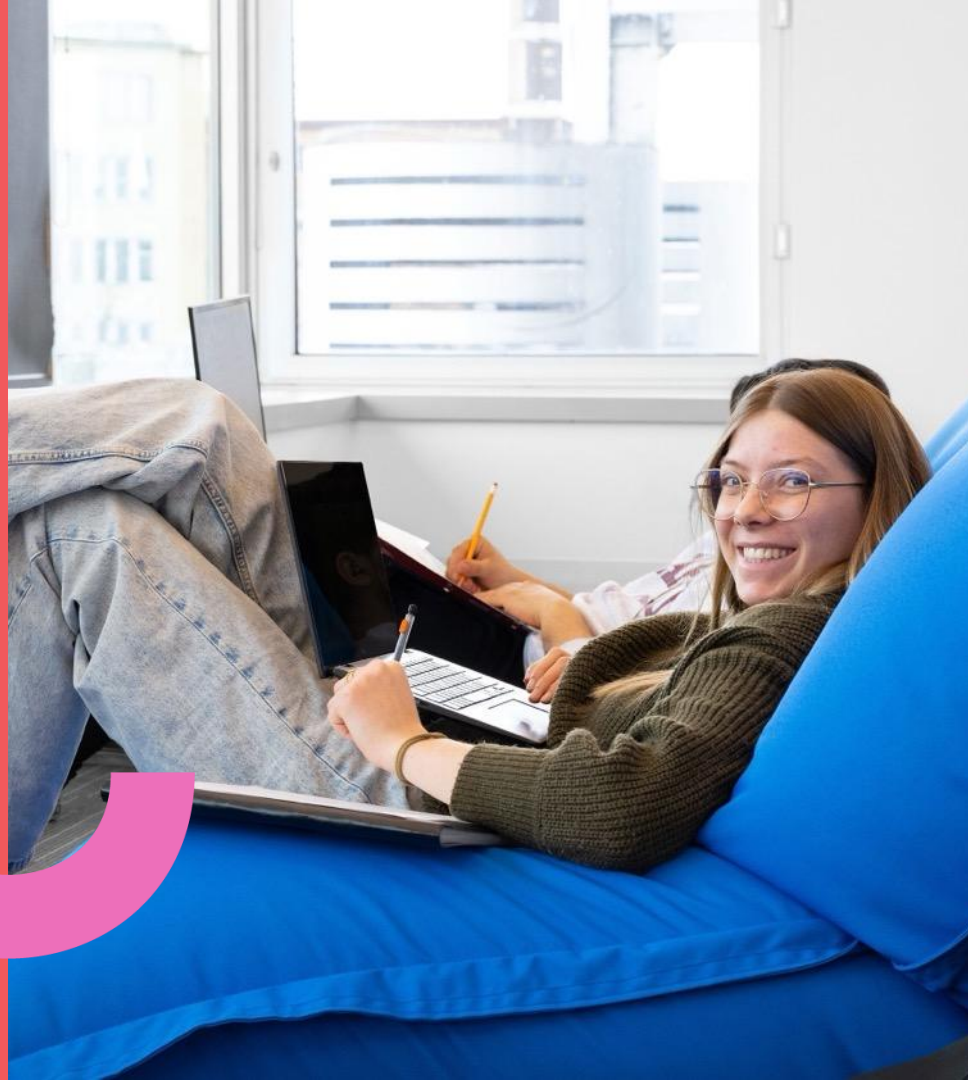
Mobility Scholarships

Support for student mobility

- International Exchange Program (BAA) - Regional campus with travel
- Summer School in Creativity Management (MOSAIC)
- Participation in an international youth summit (Youth Forum)
- International mobility and short-stay scholarship outside Quebec (M.Sc.)
- Unpaid or low-paid projects recognized by the program (Data collection, Supervised project, Internship, Other international projects.)

Personal documents

- Curriculum vitae
- Complete and consistent budget
- Answers to the questions on the form and cover letter for certain scholarships

Supporting documents

- Transcript from HEC Montréal
- AFE calculation statement
- Letter of recommendation for certain scholarships only (sae.candidatures@hec.ca)
- Copy of lease
- Copy of children's birth certificates
- Others depending on the characteristics of the scholarship

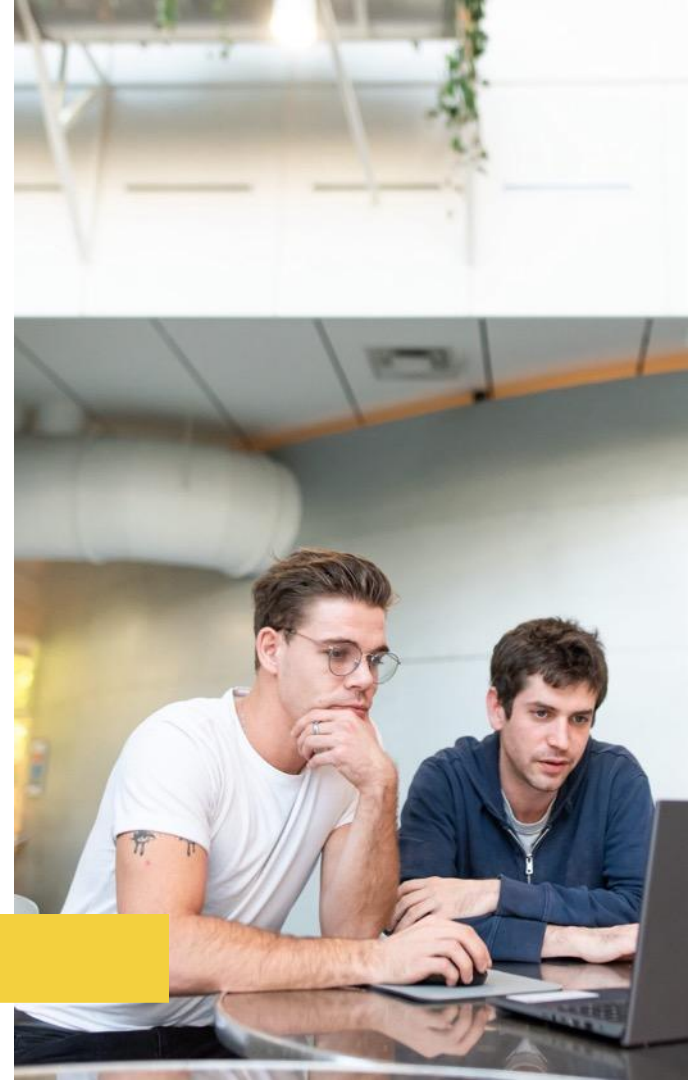
