### **Application for a study permit from the Government of Canada.**

You must now submit your study permit application to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) along with this letter. To obtain the instruction guide and forms for applying for a study permit, visit the [IRCC website](#). Given the [processing times](#) for applications, we recommend that you submit your [study permit application](#) now.

### **Certificate of acceptance from Québec**

Once your study permit comes into effect, your Certificate of Acceptance will only be valid for the educational institution, level of study and duration stated in this confirmation letter.

You may change your study program, but it must remain within the same educational institution and be at the same level or cycle as the one listed on your CAQ. You will need to obtain a new Certificate of Acceptance for Studies for any other changes, unless you are in [a situation where you do not need one](#).

This letter should be used to:

- Submit your application for a study permit to the Government of Canada;
- Meet the requirements of educational institutions regarding the submission of a Certificate of acceptance for studies.

Please note that the number on your Certificate of acceptance for studies is the same as the file number indicated at the top of this letter.

**Important:** The Certificate of Acceptance only represents the Government of Québec's consent for a temporary stay. To extend your stay in Québec, you will need to submit a new application for temporary selection.

If you wish to extend your studies, it is strongly recommended that you begin the application process **at least three months** before your authorization expires.

### **Compliance with the conditions and obligations relating to the Certificate of acceptance and study permit;**

During your study stay in Québec, it is important to comply with the [conditions and obligations](#) associated with your Certificate of acceptance for studies and that of your study permit, including:

- Study at the level of education and within the educational institution for which you have been accepted;
- Make studying your primary activity;
- Have health insurance and hospitalization insurance for yourself and any family members accompanying you for the entire duration of your stay.


